

A Logical Proof on the Existence of God (Allah)

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Here is a logical definition of God based on intelligence:

A- Definition A: God is the most intelligent being in the world, with an extremely high intelligence that matches his greatness.

Let us suppose that God doesn't exist

Then, who created everything?

We have two possibilities (case 1 and case 2):

- 1- **Case 1:** Nothing has created everything
- 2- **Case 2:** Something has created everything

In the first case, we have a nonsense: how could nothing create everything? Therefore, this case has to be eliminated.

In the second case, let us give the name "*Designer*" to the thing who/that created everything

Then we have two possibilities too (case 2.1 and case 2.2):

- 2.1. **Case 2.1:** The *Designer* is less intelligent than human beings
- 2.2. **Case 2.2:** The *Designer* is more intelligent than human beings

In the first case, we have a nonsense: how could a less intelligent thing create a human being who is more intelligent? Therefore, this case has to be eliminated.

Consequently, the only valid case is the second one, which leads to the conclusion: The *Designer* is more intelligent than human beings.

Since the human being is considered as the most intelligent thing/being one could observe in the universe, and according to the statement 2.2, the *Designer* is the most intelligent being in the world. Thus, this *Designer* should be a superpower intelligence who created everything and who is far more intelligent than human beings.

Again, according to the first definition (A) this superpower intelligence (*Designer*) corresponds to the definition of God: the most intelligent being in the world, with an extremely high intelligence that matches his greatness.

Consequently, God (Allah), as defined, does exist.

Note: the name of God is Allah in the Islamic religion.
